Controllers



Hunter[®] controllers are among the most reliable and user friendly available today. The Pro-C and its cousin PCC are light commercial quality controllers that offer many features. The main difference between the two is the Pro-C

starts as a 4 station controller and is expandable up to 16 stations by adding modules while the PCC is a fixed station controller. Either option would be an ideal controller for your yard and come standard on every one of our installations.

The X-Core is a solid residential quality controller that offers almost all of the features of the Pro-C or PCC. It's a fixed station controller available up to 8 stations. If you don't mind giving up a couple of features this controller can be substituted on your system and you will save approximately \$30 - \$50.

Rain Sensors



A rain sensor is a small device connected to the controller that prevents your sprinklers from turning on after receiving an adequate amount of rainfall. There are both wired and wireless models available. We typically use a wired rain sensor that connects directly back to the controller. There are several different options including Solar Sync[™] which effectively turns a Hunter[®] compatible controller (all the controllers we install are compatible) into a *smart* controller adjusting daily for changes in sunlight and temperature. Valves



The professional grade valves (PGV) from Hunter[®] are a proven workhorse. The purpose of a valve is to keep water at bay until the controller sends a small electric current through wires underground that actuate the connected electric solenoid. Once activated water is now allowed to flow through the valve downstream to the connected sprinklers. This is how we are able to separate different sets of sprinklers into zones (also referred to as stations or sections).

Rotor Sprinklers



Hunter[®] PGP & PGJ rotors are the gold standard by which all other rotors are measured. With the ability to cover more square footage per zone than traditional spray sprinklers this is the ideal choice for large sized areas. This durable and reliable sprinkler will keep your lawn beautiful for many years to come.
